

LIST OF ITEMS

Food and household items:

1. Peanut butter and canned meats (not salmon or ham)
2. Lysol Wipes – 80 wipes per container – 8 containers per month
3. Paper towels – 48 single rolls per month
4. Green garbage bags – 100 count – 26” x 32 ½” or 66 cm x 82.5 cm – 1 box per month
5. White garbage bags – 22” x 21” or 55.8 cm by 53.3 cm – 2 boxes per month
6. Pine-sol – 1 gallon or 3.78 L per month
7. Bathroom tissue – 96 rolls per month
8. Toilet bowl cleaner – 24 oz or 710 ml – 4 per month
9. Glass cleaner – 32 oz or 950 ml – 3 per month
10. Drain cleaner – 2 gal or 7.6 L per month
11. Dish soap – 30 oz or 887 ml – 4 per month
12. Dishwasher soap – 2.6 L – 2 per month
13. Bleach – 3.6 L – 2 per month
14. Liquid hand soap – 16.9 oz – 2 per month
15. Bar soap – 90g – 10 per month
16. Hand Sanitizer – 236 ml – 2 per month
17. Shampoo – 400 ml – 5 per month
18. Vinegar - 1 gal or 3.79 L per month
19. Bleach – 3.6 litre – 2 per month
20. Bathroom tub and sink cleaner – 32 oz or 946 ml – 5 per month
21. Laundry detergent – 4 large boxes or containers of liquid per month
22. AA batteries, duct tape and sidewalk salt

Supplies for our guys:

1. Books and DVDs like Harry Potter, Lord of the Rings, Star Wars
2. Classic board games like Monopoly, Game of Life or Chess
3. Road hockey balls
4. Flip-flops in summer and non-slip slippers in winter
