Who are we?

The Windsor Residence for Young Men is a charitable organization that promotes the health, personal skills, and social empowerment of homeless young men.

What do we do?

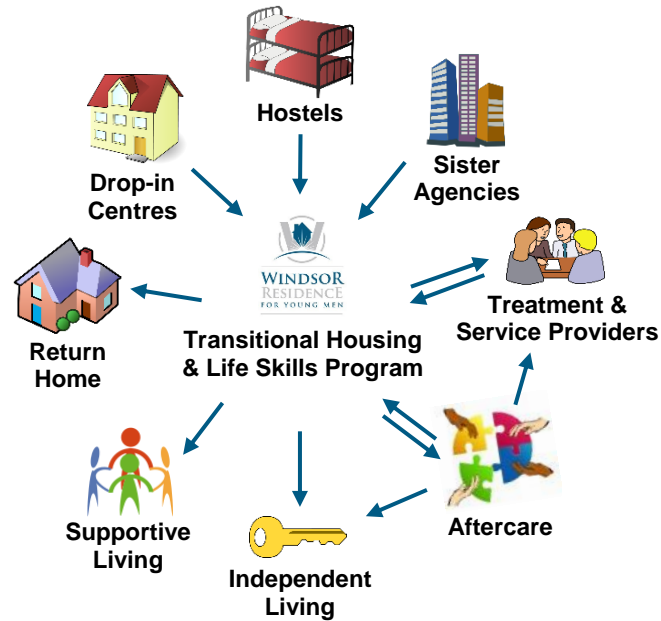
We end homelessness for young men. Our most successful residents are 16 – 20 years of age.

We are averaging 50 admissions per year with a 90% success rate:

- One third return to extended family
- Two thirds are established in independent living appropriate to their needs
- 70% stay in or return to school
- 40% find employment while with us

We offer our guys a hand up, not a handout.

Collaboration of agencies



How do we do it?

We provide a safe, nurturing home to young homeless men while staff mentor them in these important skills:

- **Hygiene** – personal, social, and domestic
- **Food Acquisition and Preparation** – for a healthy diet
- **Social Responsibility** not entitlement
- **Work Ethic** – for kids who often have not learned to use a snow shovel or lawn mower, having come from unstable multiple unit housing
- **Budgeting**
- **Accessing existing services** in our community
- **Aftercare** – following them when they leave us, assisting them in times of crisis, and inviting them back home again if necessary – as any good parent would
